What is the certification process?

The EFL Certification is designed to meet the needs of busy professionals. The certification process consists of completion of two online modules and one 3-day intensive workshop. You are also required to have 3 mentoring sessions with your module instructor (1 per module).

Our online modules are self-paced, which means that you do not have to be at your computer at a set time each week for class. Instead, you can work at your own pace, in your own time, over the course of the 3 week module. Each week, there will be a video presentation, and some required reading. You will need to engage in complete one written assignment each week, and post comments in the discussion forum on the online learning platform.

At the end of the online module, you will be required to schedule a mentoring session with the online module instructor. This is a one hour session during which you can ask questions and/or explore this module's material in more detail, and get some support from your instructor, and advice for your development moving forward.

Once you have completed the two online modules, you can register for the 3-day Intensive workshop. This is the final step in your certification process. You must attend all 3 days of the workshop in order to graduate the program.

You may take the online modules at your convenience on the available dates throughout the year, but they must be taken in sequence (i.e Module 1 followed by Module 2).
