EFL Certification Requirements

The program is designed to be flexible and accessible to a wide range of practitioners. Participants fulfill the following requirements to graduate:

- 2 Online Modules
- 1 x 3 Day Intensive following completion of online modules
- 3 hours of individual mentoring with a faculty member*

**Once the minimum requirements have been reached for graduation, students are encouraged to continue in regular mentoring to ensure continuous learning to maintain their Graduate Membership.*
